



The Museum of Scottish Fire Heritage is recruiting for a **Digital Content Creator** to highlight and share our Maths Week Scotland 2023 activity.

The Museum of Scottish Fire Heritage is a newly opened museum in Edinburgh. We love to use our collection and knowledge of the history and evolution of firefighting in Scotland to explore a variety of topical themes. Our stories and collections are ideally placed to explore maths due to the integral link between maths and the basics of utilising water for effective firefighting.

## **OUR THEME**

### ***Firefighting: The Sums of Water***

- We will explore how firefighters use the mathematics of water to do their jobs. There are practical examples of the way they need to determine distance, force, velocity, and water pressure.

### **Our planned activities are:**

2 x drop in gallery-based activities for under 5's and 6-9 years age groups  
1 x bookable Family Friendly Workshop for ages 9 and above (30-45 mins duration).

## **JOB SPECIFICATION**

Filming and content generation of 1 workshop video for our website and 2 short promotional videos for social media use:

- Record, edit and caption a video of our Family Friendly workshop on Saturday 21 October so it can be uploaded onto our website (30 minutes).
- Record and edit footage of our drop-in gallery activities Saturday 21 October.
- Use generated footage to develop/edit 2 short promotional videos for use on social media (30 seconds to 1 minute maximum).

## **SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE**

- Filming and editing skills including editing for online use.
- Experience of capturing learning activities for use across a variety of formats
- Experience and ability to capture learning activities in a fun and engaging way for a range of audiences
- Knowledge and consideration of accessibility, inclusion and diversity needs when creating content for online use.

**Employment:** The digital content creator will be employed on a freelance basis September to October 2023.

**Rate of Pay:** £850 flat fee to include all development and delivery time. This fee includes any travel and subsistence expenses you may incur. We anticipate capture and editing to take approximately 16-18 hours
